## **Club Rules and Regulations**

## **General Rules**

- 1. Please respect; opponents, your partner, others on or near the court and club property.
- 2. Only proper tennis attire is permitted while playing tennis. Shorts, shirt, and flat soled, non-marking tennis shoes required. Running shoes and heavily treaded shoes are not permitted on court.
- 3. No animals allowed on club premises.
- 4. Visitors must pay before they can play tennis at the club. Payments to be made to Security at the gate or alternatively the Club Coach on court 3. A register of visitors must be completed to accompany payment.

Adult Visitor: N\$ 60.00Junior Visitor: N\$ 30.00

• Use of Lights: N\$ 30.00 (per hour, per player). Light fees payable at the Bar unless otherwise advised.

• Balls for Socials (Members only): N\$ 30.00

• Balls for Visitors: N\$ 50.00

NOTE: visitors not at the club to play tennis do not need to pay visitors' fees.

- 5. No glass bottles, open liquid containers and or alcohol on court.
- 6. Children under 12 are not allowed inside the courts unless accompanied by an adult, instructor, or parent.
- 7. Current members, in good standing, will receive a 5% reduction in membership fees applied to the following year for each new member they recruit to the club, provided the following is true.
  - Upon application the new member identifies the referring member in writing/on the application form
  - Club Treasurer has the discretion in determining the allocation of award in the event of competing claims or questionable circumstances. Decisions by the Treasurer can be appealed in writing to the CTC Committee
  - This rule only applies to new members recruited and not returning or newly paid up members
  - Total number of awards shall not exceed the total amount of the annual membership due
  - This policy may be rescinded at any future time by the CTC Committee without advance notice and not affecting pending awards

- 8. Wednesdays and Saturdays are reserved for Member Socials. Courts are designated on premises accordingly. Tuesdays are designated for Ladies socials.
- 9. Please use bins provided to keep the courts clear of litter.
- 10. Please avoid using cellphones during play on the courts.
- 11. Please do not use abusive language on the courts and inside the club.
- 12. Smoking on the premises only allowed at the designated area (ask the bar for directions).
- 13. Sportsmanship is non-negotiable. Your opponent must be given the benefit of the doubt during play and competition. When unsure a ball is "out", it will be called "in".
- 14. Have fun and keep tennis fun for others!

## **Prevailing Tennis Rules**

1. Unless agreed upon otherwise, official rules from the Namibia Tennis Association (NTA) shall govern play.
